



#### **USI Number**

#### Hi Everyone

All students enrolled in a certificate course need a USI (Unique Student Identifier) number. This number will give the students access to their online USI account which will contain all their nationally recognised training records and results. This will allow the students to have easy access to their training records and results throughout their life. As an RTO delivering a certificate course, we need to gather this number and verify it for our records.

During your next lesson with your students, could you please spend a brief moment explaining the USI system and asking them to hop online and register for a USI if they have not done so already? Some students already have a USI number. If they do not have the necessary ID at school (most will not) ask them to go home and register and give it to you in the next lesson. The process is very simple and usually takes only a few minutes. They will need **one** of the following items:

- 1. Licence (Learner licence is acceptable)
- 2. Medicare card
- 3. Australian Passport
- 4. Birth Certificate
- 5. Various other items for non-Australian citizens

#### Step 1 Have at least one of the ID items on them

Step 2 Visit the USI website at usi.gov.au

Step 3 Select 'Student Entry' and then Select 'Create a USI' link and follow the steps.

**Step 4 Agree to the Terms and Conditions** 

Step 5 Follow the instructions – should only take a few minutes. Upon completion, the USI will be displayed on the screen and emailed to you.

Step 6 Write down the USI and give a copy to your teacher. Please ensure it is written down correctly as most verification errors come from entering it in incorrectly. Save a copy to your phone or somewhere safe.

Encourage students to use their own personal email address when registering and a password and questions that they are likely to remember forever.
