Woolloongabba Community Health Centre

Metro South Health has opened a dental clinic at 228 Logan Road, Woolloongabba, to provide general, specialist and emergency oral health care to the local community.

This includes preventative, general, emergency and specialist services delivered by a multidisciplinary oral health team, including:

- » dental therapy and hygiene services for children, adolescents and adults
- » general and emergency services for children, adolescents and adults
- » specialist oral services oral surgery, endodontics, orthodontics, periodontics and paedodontics (eligibility and category criteria apply for specialist services)
- » patient education and teaching
- » denture or prosthesis manufacture, maintenance and adjustment
- » community education programs.

The Centre includes:

- » 27 dental chairs
- » dedicated facilities for dental x-rays
- » family appointments
- » modern and comfortable reception and patient waiting areas.

All school children from Prep through to Year 10 are eligible for free dental care.

Who is eligible?

Adults

Adults are eligible for free public dental care if they hold a Medicare card **and** one of the following:

- » Pensioner Concession Card (issued by the Department of Veterans' Affairs or Centrelink)
- » Health Care Card
- » Commonwealth Seniors Health Card
- » Queensland Seniors Card.

Children and adolescents

Children are eligible for free public dental care if they hold a Medicare Card **and** are one of the following:

- » aged 4 years through to students in Year 10
- » students in Years 11 or 12 who have a current Centrelink, Health Care or Pension Card
- » aged 0-3 years whose parents have a current Centrelink, Health Care or Pension Card
- » aged 2-17 years who are eligible for the Child Dental Benefits Schedule (CDBS).
