

Dear Parents and Carers of current Grade 10 students

It is time for a free dental check-up and dental treatment before your child finishes Grade 10.

All children from age 4 to Grade 10 are eligible for free dental care from Metro South Oral Health Service if they hold a Medicare card. **This may be their last chance to access free dental care.**

Dental appointments are available now at many clinics. Simply call **1300 300 850** to book an appointment at a location of your choice. Making an appointment before Term 4 is recommended.

Free children's dental care is available from Metro South Oral Health for:

- all children aged 4 to grade 10 who are eligible for Medicare
- children aged 2 -17 years who are eligible for the Child Dental Benefits Schedule, and
- children whose parents have a current Centrelink Card, Healthcare or Pension Card.
- Any young children including their siblings referred by the Child Health Nurse at a Child Health Clinic through the *Lift the Lip Program*.
