

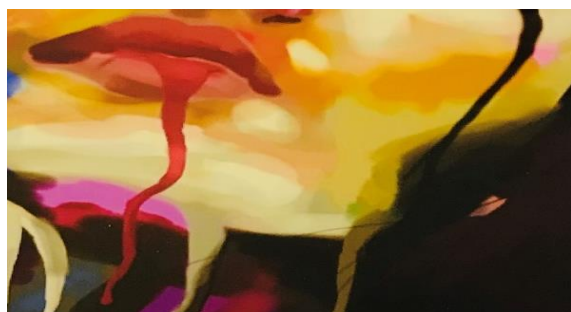

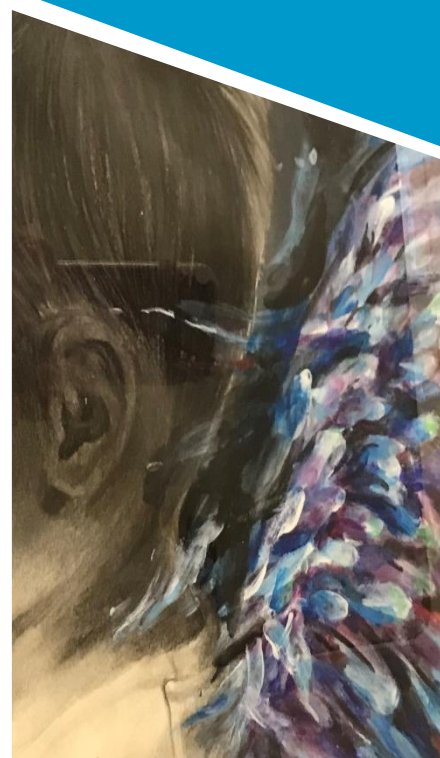
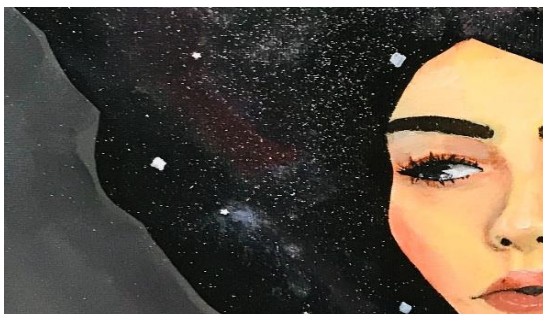
We are not an ideal. The thought is both disappointing and relieving.
