Brushed – Student artwork



Brushed provides opportunity for students in secondary schools studying Art and/or individual students pursuing art, independent of the subject. Students need to apply, via the Influence Brisbane application form, and then submit a piece of artwork to the Mt Gravatt Showgrounds, ready to be hung. Successfully judged students will be invited to have their work exhibited in the

People's Gallery at City Hall.

The Influence Brisbane Brushed exhibition will run from 6—13 August.

The Beat – Student music



The Beat supports students in secondary schools studying Music and/or individual students pursuing music, independent of the subject.

Students need to apply, via the Influence Brisbane application form, for a performance spot at the Mt Gravatt Show, where they will be given a twenty (20) minute bump in, bump out set in which they perform.

All student musicians who enter into the Influence Brisbane—The Beat program will be judged for suitability to go on and play at one of our organised professional gigs in Brisbane. This year vetted students will also be forwarded to the Royal Queensland Show - Entertainment section, where they will be eligible to performance at the 2022 Royal Queensland Show (Ekka).

• *The Pitch* – Student entrepreneurs



The Pitch aims to identify and help students in secondary schools who have started or implemented an idea that they intend to grow and market. Students need to apply to the Mt Gravatt Show, via the Influence Brisbane application form, for a position within the organised entrepreneur workshops.
