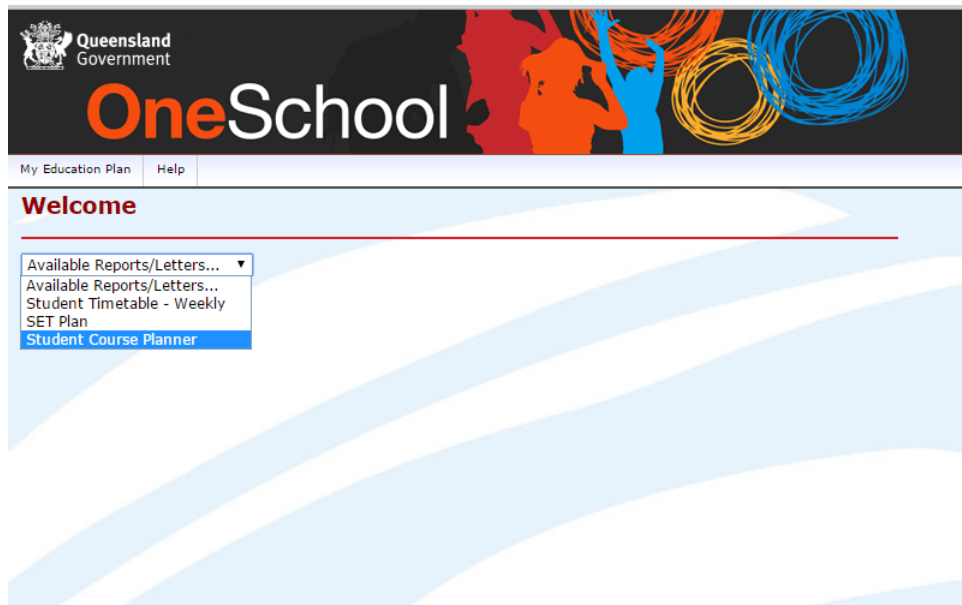


Accessing your Course & Assessment Planners
